

THE TRUE COST OF DEFENSE

Robert Chatfield is President and Chief Executive Officer of [Free To Choose® Network](#) (FTCN), a global media organization, and serves as Executive Producer for the one-hour public television documentary, [The True Cost of Defense](#).

During his eight years at FTCN, Chatfield served as Executive Producer on six previous public television projects and numerous stand-alone educational videos. He previously worked with Judge Douglas Ginsburg, U.S. Court of Appeals, D.C. Circuit, on the three-part PBS series, [A More or Less Perfect Union](#), about the U.S. Constitution and on a one-hour program, [We Hold These Truths](#), about the Declaration of Independence. Chatfield and Judge Ginsburg subsequently developed [CivicsFundamentals.org](#), a video-based, online civics course for students and immigrants studying to pass the U.S. Citizenship Test.

Chatfield's other public television documentary credits include [Free To Speak](#), a three-part series on free speech hosted by Nadine Strossen, [Corporate Welfare: Where's the Outrage?](#) and [Sweden: Lessons for America?](#), hosted by Cato Senior Fellow Johan Norberg, and [Thomas Sowell: Common Sense in a Senseless World](#), hosted by *The Wall Street Journal's* Jason Riley.

Chatfield is a lifelong learner, a community servant, and an adventurer. He has long served as an adjunct professor for several colleges and universities, including a one-year visiting professor assignment at Suffolk University's campus in Dakar, Senegal. Additionally, Chatfield has participated in several humanitarian missions with Rotary International in the Dominican Republic, India, and Senegal.
